

Application procedure for carrier codes

Communication No 528/2015, Official Gazette No 11/2015 of 10 June 2015

1. Legal basis

The Numbering plan for carrier codes has been determined separately as a general administrative order (see Administrative Order No 21/2015 of 10 June 2015) and provides the basis for their assignment and use.

Under section 66(1) third sentence of the Telecommunications Act (TKG) of 22 June 2004 (Federal Law Gazette I page 1190ff), as amended by Article 22 of the Act of 25 July 2014 (Federal Law Gazette I page 1266), in conjunction with section 4 of the Telecommunications Numbering Ordinance (TNV) (Federal Law Gazette I page 141ff, as amended by Article 4(110) of the Act of 7 August 2013 (Federal Law Gazette I page 3154)), the Bundesnetzagentur assigns numbers to telecommunications network operators, telecommunications service providers and end users. Under section 5(1) of the Ordinance, the Bundesnetzagentur can specify in particular the form of applications for number use.

2. Applications

Applications for the assignment of a carrier code should be made using the form provided by the Bundesnetzagentur (see annex).

3. Processing of applications

Hand-delivered applications will be stamped by the Bundesnetzagentur with the date of receipt on working days from 07.30 to 16.15 on Mondays to Thursdays and from 7.30 to 15.00 on Fridays.

Applications will be processed in the order in which they are received (as shown by the Bundesnetzagentur's date stamp). Relevant in determining this is the time at which the complete application is received. All applications received in the course of one day will be considered as having been received at the same time. Applications placed in the Bundesnetzagentur's letter box will be considered as received on the next working day.

If two or more applicants with equal priority apply for the same carrier code at the same time, the decision about who is to be assigned the code will be taken by drawing lots. Unsuccessful applicants will be assigned one of the remaining available codes in accordance with the wishes stated on their application.

Each applicant/company will be assigned only one carrier code.

Fees are charged for any processing of applications. Incomplete applications will be rejected.

4. Entry into force

The regulations laid down in this Communication will be applied as from 11 June 2015.
