Application procedure for (0)18 numbers for virtual private networks (VPNs)

1. Legal basis and purpose of the regulations

Under section 66(1) third sentence of the Telecommunications Act (TKG) of 22 June 2004 (Federal Law Gazette I page 1190), as amended by Article 4(108) of the Act of 7 August 2013 (Federal Law Gazette I page 3154), in conjunction with section 4 of the Telecommunications Numbering Ordinance (TNV) of 5 February 2008 (Federal Law Gazette I No 5 of 14 February 2008, pages 141ff), as amended by Article 4(110) of the Act of 7 August 2013 (Federal Law Gazette I page 3154), the Bundesnetzagentur assigns numbers to telecommunications network operators, providers of telecommunication services and end users. Under section 5(1) of the Ordinance, the Bundesnetzagentur can specify in particular the details of application for the use of numbers. These details are to be published.

This Communication contains such details specified and describes the application procedure for numbers for virtual private networks (VPNs).

The Numbering plan for VPN numbers has been issued separately as a general administrative order (Administrative Order No 48/2014, Bundesnetzagentur Official Gazette No 16 of 3 September 2014) and provides the basis for their assignment and use.

2. Applications

An application for assignment of a number block can be made to the

3. Processing of applications

3.1 Processing of applications

The Bundesnetzagentur assigns the applicant a number block for a VPN.

Applicants are not entitled to a specific number block.

Incomplete applications will be rejected.

3.2 Fees

Fees are charged for any processing of applications.

The fees payable will be specified in a separate notice.

4. Entry into force

The provisions set out in this Communication will be applied as from 1 October 2014.
